I have a problem that I dont know how to solve in mysql. I have a table, of customers that has a lot of records. And I have a procedure that calculates different rates for each customer. I want to use the same table for this purpose and I dont know how to optimize it, the customer table has 20 million records and I can't put the rates in another table. I made a little diagram in my head to see how this could be solved It is something like this, but now I cant find any examples of this. Can someone help me with this? A: If you have a sufficiently fast engine, and if your data is static enough (that is, the percentage is fixed across all of the records and the calculation isn't that expensive to make), then you can just create a view and use the indexes on that view instead of the table. For example: CREATE VIEW Customers AS SELECT CustomerId, Rate FROM Customers; CREATE INDEX Customers_Rate ON Customers(Rate); If you have to calculate the percentage regularly, then it would be better to either store it in the database (I prefer this method) or calculate it in the application. A: The first step would be to partition the table in such a way that each partition has an index over the rows for that customer (20 million rows will fit on a disk easily), and add an index on the "calculation factor". If that is too expensive, you could partition on the last name and zip code. 2d92ce491b
